Hi, and thanks for your interest in this online class.

These colourful mosaic style quilts are fun to make and are a suitable project for sewers of all abilities. There are (obviously!) 12 designs to choose from, each one measuring 12 inches square when finished. They can be made as individual quilts or joined together to make a larger wall hanging. This class is to make 1 of the designs. Further patterns are available from Claire.

How the class works:

It is important to note that this is not a sew-along class. Claire will demonstrate the step-by-step process she uses to create the mosaics using batik fabrics and a fusible web such as Steam-a-seam 2. You then make your chosen design in your own time, either the same day or at some time in the future.

The class will be taught using the Zoom platform along with additional short videos which will also be available to view online after the class.

The zoom class will start at 10am and run till around noon with a short break sometime in the middle. Claire will demonstrate how to make the mosaics and everyone can chat and ask questions as we go. By the end of the morning you should have a clear understanding of how to make your own mosaic quilt.

At 4pm the same day there will be another zoom get together where you can share what you have made and ask any further questions and share ideas.

Fabric Requirements

Kits for each of the quilts are available on the Midsomer Quilting website (www.midsomerg.com).

However, if you source these items yourself you will need:

Base fabric: 13" x 13" black cotton fabric

Binding: 13" x 7" black cotton fabric

Steam-a-seam (or similar): 20"

Freezer Paper: 13" x 13"

For the Mosaic pieces you will need a selection of batik fabrics. If you decide to buy a kit it will contain the correct quantities of the required colours. If you are sourcing your own fabrics please email Claire and tell her which Star Sign you want to make and she will send you the specific requirements for that kit.
